Contractors are reminded that Bridging and quick start contraception will become a mandatory part of the Clinical Community Pharmacy Service (CCPS) from 1 April 2023 and all contractors must complete the component listing form to confirm provision by 31 March 2023 at the latest (or will not receive the Establishment Payment (Clinical Services) for April 2023).

Prior to listing, contractors are advised to ensure that their pharmacists have completed all the required accreditation requirements on NCSA (as once listed the pharmacy will be visible on 111 as "providing the service").
