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## Improvements to the NEO harm reduction database

This is a reminder of the changes to the Needle and Syringe Programme (NSP) module that were introduced from the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022.

### On the client details page

1. Current drug use information, both injecting and non-injecting drug use, will need to be entered before a NSP transaction can be completed for all service users. This applies to the first transaction from the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 or for the first transaction completed that does not already have this information recorded.
2. In situations where an individual only uses one drug type and does not use both injecting and non-injecting drugs additional drop downs have been added. Please see below.
