

Contraception Services

As of the 1st April 2023, the “Emergency Contraception” and “Bridging Contraception” services have merged, to create a new service called “Contraception Services”.

This means it is no longer possible to be accredited in either one of the above services alone. It also means that as these services are no longer existing in isolation, if either service is due to expire, or you have not completed one of the modules, you will be required to submit a new Statement of Competence form via the NCSA hub, which will then be sent to Shared Services. ***Please remember pharmacies will need to list their premises separately, to ensure they are compliant with the CCPS service contractual requirements.***

A flow chart on what you will need to complete is detailed below to help you.
