Back Pain		Patients 18-50 years (exclude red flag, diabetic /immunocompromised/cancer patients)	
Chicken Pox		Patients 2months to <14 years (unless systemically unwell)	
Cold Sores*		All patients >6months except, near term pregnant, immunocompromised, severe /secondary infection/ sores on eyes/genitals	
Colic*		All infants (GP if systemically unwell)	
Conjunctivitis		Refer to Welsh Eye Care Service if available or to pharmacy Patients > 2 years (except pregnant /breastfeeding/visual disturbance/pain)	
Constipation		Patients >18 years unless red flag symptoms	
Diarrhoea*		Patients 4 weeks to 65 years	
Dry Eyes		Refer to Welsh Eye Care Service if available, if not all 18years	
Dry skin/Dermatitis		All patients > 1 month(GP if secondary infection)	
Haemorrhoids(Piles)		Patients > 18 years of age unless pregnant	
Hay Fever		Patients > 2 years (GP if pregnant)	
Head Lice		All patients > 6 months	
Indigestion/Reflux		Patients >18 years unless red flag symptoms	
Ingrowing Toenail*		All patients except diabetics	
Mouth Ulcers		Patients > 12 years	
Nappy Rash		All infants (GP if systemically unwell or if infected)	
Oral thrush		Patients > 4 weeks old	
Ringworm/Intertrigo (sweat rash)		All patients > 1 month (GP if immunocompromised/poorly controlled diabetic/recurrent infection/ringworm on scalp)	
Scabies		Patients > 2 years (GP if secondary infection)	
Sore Throat/ STTT		All patients 2 and over (6 and over for STTT) (GP if systemically unwell/persistent symptoms/ immunocompromised)	
Teething		Children > 3 months (GP if systemically unwell)	
Threadworm		Patients > 6 months (excludes pregnant/breastfeeding)	
Vaginal Thrush		Females 16-60 years (excludes poorly controlled diabetic/pregnant or breastfeeding/immunocompromised patients)	
Warts and Verruca		Patients > 2 years (exclude diabetic/poor circulation/multiple lesions/bleeding/pain/on face or anogenital areas)	

* advice only- no NHS treatment given, patients advised on self care
